

## Jewish Passover

Melchizedek, *high priest* offers up bread and wine as a sacrifice for Abraham's victory. King of righteousness and peace.

*Exodus*-from slavery to freedom, *lamb's blood* on the door posts saves the Israelite sons. Done in the evening.

*Angel* passed over the first born sons of the Israelites and saved them.

*Manna*, bread from heaven is given in the desert. Seder supper begins with candle lighting-presence of God. Unleaven bread.

God gives *living water* in the desert to the thirsty.

The *Temple*- house of God where God is centrally worshipped.

*Flame* before the Tabernacle in the Holy of Holies.

*Mercy Seat* located in the Temple.

Spring harvest feast is *bread* offered up. Fall harvest feast is the *wine* offered up.

*Priest* washes hands before the sacrifice. Priests from the family of Levi/ Aaron.

Sacrifices in the Temple end when the Romans destroy the Temple in 70 A.D.

Do this Passover in remembrance of me yearly, God.

They all ate manna according to their needs and were satisfied.

## Catholic Mass

Jesus is the new *High Priest*. He is the prince of peace and all righteousness. He becomes the perfect sacrifice forever.

*Jesus' exodus* is his death and resurrection. His blood offered to free all from human slavery to receive new life. Darkness covered the earth.

*Angels* appear to Jesus at his temptations & in the Garden of Gethsemane.

*Bread* for the Eucharist, making present Jesus' sacrifice. Heaven comes to earth. Jesus is light of the world. Unleavened bread.

Jesus is the *living water* that will quench all our thirst.

Jesus is the new *Temple* where God will be worshipped. We are temples of the Holy Spirit. Jesus is in churches, etc.

*Candle* always before the tabernacle.

Jesus is merciful. He said blessed are the merciful. Mercy Sunday.

*Bread and wine* the premiere crops are used by Jesus in the Mass to be transformed into His body & blood.

Priest washes his hands before the Sacrifice on the altar. Priests from any family.

Sacrifice of the Mass never ends making a perpetual sacrifice of Jesus' life, death and resurrection.

Do this in remembrance of Me daily, Jesus.

Loaves & fishes & Eucharist, "they all ate and were satisfied."
