Sins can occur one time.

habitually. rarely.

Ripple effects of Sin: sins cause

- 1. separation from others.
- 2. feel dirty, uncomfortable with self.
- 3. alienation from God.
- 4. neglect and abuse of nature.

Seven Capital Sins:

anger, covetousness, envy, gluttony, lust, pride and sloth.

Mortal sins require three conditions to be present at the same time:

- 1. serious offense.
- 2. conscious of what you are doing at the time.
- 3. consenting to commit a mortal sin at the time.

Ways to overcome sin:

Act of Contrition
Sacrament of Reconciliation
Mass and Eucharist
A Life Confession.
